



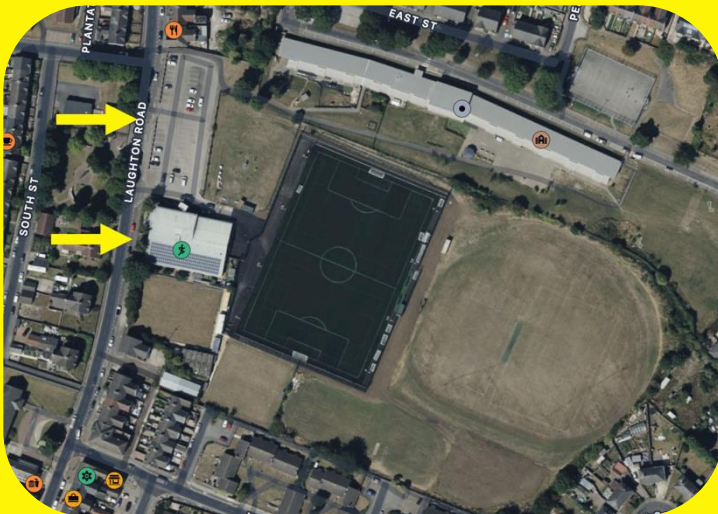
Dinnington Town JFC Visiting Team Guide

Key information:

- Phoenix Park, Dinnington, S25 2PP.
- 3G pitch so appropriate footwear is mandatory for players & coaches.
- Onsite parking.
- Onsite catering including hot & cold food and drink, including the sale of alcohol.
- Onsite toilets.
- Smoking permitted in designated areas.
- Dogs allowed on a lead.



Location:

- Our ground is located at Phoenix Park, Dinnington, Sheffield, S25 2PP.
- Parking is highlighted opposite.
- You then access the pitch through the Dinnington Resource Centre front door which is on Laughton Road (see map).
- An overflow car park is located on Constable Lane, S25 2AG.
- The facility is disabled access friendly.

Match Information

All home games are played on a 3G pitch so appropriate footwear must be worn by anybody accessing the pitch.

Footwear rules apply to both players & coaches. Failure to wear the correct footwear will mean players won't be able to play and coaches will have to coach from behind the fences.

Pitch rules:

- Only players, coaches and physios are allowed on the pitch.
- Under no circumstances whatsoever are spectators allowed on the pitch.
- No flat soled shoes or trainers by anyone entering the pitch including coaches or physios.
- Boots must be clean of mud and grass.
- No folding subs benches are allowed on the pitch. For 11-a-side matches use of the permanent dugouts is permitted by both teams.
- No glass or bottles on the pitch
- No smoking, food or chewing gum whilst on the pitch.

RECOMMENDED FOOTWEAR

Moulded or short screw in studs Short blades Hybrid studs and blades

Incorrect footwear may damage the turf, but more importantly may increase the risk of injury.

NO FLAT SOLED SHOES OR TRAINERS

To enjoy, protect and preserve the surface please help by observing the pitch rules:

- Footwear should be clean of loose mud and grass
- Only players and coaches with the recommended footwear on the playing surface
- No glass bottles, cans, food, chewing gum
- No smoking
- Dispose of litter, loose tape, plastic bottles and other waste, before leaving the pitch



You're required to clear up litter, loose tape, plastic bottles and other waste before leaving the pitch after your game.

Our kit

We play in yellow shirts, black shorts and yellow socks. You'll need to ensure there isn't a kit clash when we play.

*Some junior teams play in black socks and not yellow.

Facilities

At Phoenix Park, spectators can watch games from our seated covered stand or the standing areas on three sides of the ground.

The club has the following facilities available at every home game:
